If an album is purchased, the first draft of the album will be posted for review within 2 weeks of the pictures being chosen.

The parties have read all three pages of this agreement, agree to all its terms, and acknowledge receipt of a complete copy of the Agreement signed by both parties. Each person signing as a Client below shall be fully responsible for ensuring that full payment is made according to the terms of this Agreement.

Terms and Conditions

1. Exclusive Photographer: The photographer will be the exclusive photographer retained by the Client for the purpose of photographing the wedding. Family and friends of the client are permitted to photograph the wedding as long as they do not interfere with the Photographer's duties.
2. Deposit and Payment: Bride and groom must pay deposit (half of total purchase) when contract is signed, and the other half 3 weeks prior to event date. If second payment is not made 3 weeks prior to event date then a 10% interest rate will be incurred with each week that it is not paid starting on the first day of each week. If second installment is not paid one week before the event date then Photographer is not required to attend and photograph the clients wedding, however customer is still required to pay full installment. If the installment is not paid by the event date then a 20% interest rate will be charged each consecutive month starting the 1st of each month.
3. Cancellation: If the Client cancels this Agreement 30 or more calendar days prior to the event date then the deposit in full will be reimbursed to the Client. If the Client chooses to cancel less than 30 days prior to the event they deposit shall not be reimbursed to the Client however no other payments are required of the Client. If the Client reschedules an additional deposit will be made which will be reimbursed 1 week after the second event date.
4. Photographic Materials: All photographic materials, including but not limited to negatives, transparencies, proofs, and previews, shall be the exclusive property of the Photographer. The Photographer shall make proofs and previews available to the client for the purpose of selecting photographs. The photographer may choose to provide the client with the digital negatives pending this coverage has been purchased.
5. Copyright and Reproductions: The Photographer shall own the copyright on all images created and shall have the exclusive right to make reproductions. The Photographer shall only make reproductions for the Client or for the Photographer's portfolio, samples, self-promotions, entry in photographic contests or art exhibitions, editorial use, or for display within or on the outside of the Photographer's studio. Digital negatives may be purchased.
6. Clients Usage: The Client is obtaining prints for personal use only, and shall not sell said prints or authorize any reproductions thereof by parties other than the Photographer. If Client is obtaining a print for newspaper announcement or invitations to reception for the wedding, Photographer authorizes Client to reproduce the print in this manner.
7. Failure to Perform: If the Photographer cannot perform this Agreement due to a or other causality, strike, act of God, or other cause beyond the control of the parties, or due to Photographer's illness, then the Photographer will return the deposit to the Client but shall have no further liability with respect to the Agreement. This limitation on liability shall also apply in the event that photographic materials are damaged in processing, lost through the mail, lost through camera malfunctioning, or otherwise lost or damaged without fault on the part of the Photographer. In the event the Photographer fails to perform for any other reason, the Photographer shall not be liable for any amount in excess of the retail value of the Client's order.
8. Photographer: The Photographer may substitute another photographer to take the photographs in the event of Photographer's illness or scheduling conflicts. In the event of such substitution, Photographer warrants that the photographer taking the photographs shall be a competent professional.
9. Inherent Qualities: Client is aware that dyes in Photography may fade or discolor over time due to inherent qualities of dyes, and Client releases Photographer from any liability for any claims whatsoever based upon fading or discoloration due to such inherent qualities.
10. Photographers Standard Price List: The charges in this Agreement are based on the Photographer's Standard Price List. This price list is adjusted periodically and future orders shall be charged at the prices in effect at the time when the order is placed. The price set for albums is the base price including 20 pages. Extra pages can be added at \$40 per page
11. Clients Originals: If the Client is providing original prints, negatives, or transparencies owned by the Client to the Photographer for duplication, framing, reference, or any other purpose, in the event of loss or damage the Photographer shall not be liable for any monetary losses. The photographer will be responsible for reproducing the same image in the same form as entrusted to them.
12. Arbitration: All disputes arising under this agreement shall be submitted to binding arbitration of Chas Elliott's appointment. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either party may refuse to arbitrate when the dispute is for a sum less than \$1000.
13. Miscellaneous: This Agreement incorporates the entire understanding of the parties. Any modifications of this Agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State(s) of Virginia, Maryland, District of Columbia.
